This animated video addresses the underlying questions all ask when told they, or a loved one, has diabetes. What does this mean? Can we still do the things we enjoy? How can I help?

Another video <u>Kids Talking about Diabetes with Friends</u> models how young children with diabetes can talk confidently with their friends about how they can be of help. Using a superhero theme this short video can be viewed on its own or used in group discussions.

Regardless of age, the foundation for optimal health is education that guides self-management. These videos provide critical information and skill-building produced at the CDC recommended 6th grade reading level.
